The Awards are presented in the Autumn.

The Air Safety Prize is awarded for the most important contribution made during the previous year towards improving the safety of personnel or aircraft in flight, or enhancing the survival of aircrew.

The Ground Safety Award is awarded for the most important contribution made during the previous year towards improving the safety of personnel, aircraft or equipment on the ground, either at a flying station or at an associated unit elsewhere.

Prizes Include:

£1000 Air Safety Prize

£500 Ground Safety Award

£250 To the originating Station Flight Safety

Organisation to spend on Promoting Air Safety



L G Groves lost his life whilst serving as a Meteorological Observer with 517 Sqn in 1945, along with the rest of his crew, when their Halifax aircraft crashed into high ground in bad weather. The Award Scheme and Prize Fund was established by his parents in 1946 with the aim of improving the safety of aircraft, aircrew and passengers. The Awards are now Tri-Service and are awarded annually.
